Applicants will be judged on content and neatness of application and personal essay.

Eligibility INFORMATION

- 1. Applicant must be a child or grandchild of an OSEA Chapter 48 signed member in good standing (dues paying member) as of December 31, 2018 through at least the 2018-2019 school year.
- 2. Current high school seniors and graduates may apply.
- 3. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited college or vocational school to pursue one of the following:
 - a. A specialized training program certificate or degree
 - b. A Bachelor or Associate Degree
- 4. Application must include a high school transcript if in high school currently. If the applicant is in college or attended college at any point, you must include both a high school and a most current college transcript with the application.
- Include your own typed essay of at least 500 words. As this award is coming from OSEA
 members' dues dollars; your essay must include "What being part of a Union means"
 along with describing your educational interests, plans, and activities (inside and outside of
 school/work).

This application, including the above information **must be received by Thursday April 4, 2019 by 4:00pm**. **No applications received after 4:00pm on 4/6 will be considered.** Mail the completed application to:
