AFT MEMBERS AND THEIR FAMILIES CAN EARN AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE WITH NO OUT-OF-POCKET COST

The remaining amount will be cleared with the Free College Scholarship. BEAVERTON SCHOOL DISTRICT CLASSIFIED CONTRACT

All eligible employees will be advanced a step on the salary schedule, effective July 1, 2018 and every year for the life of this contract. The salary schedule for 2018-19 will be increased by a 3 percent cost of living adjustment (COLA) and a market factor adjustment of 3 percent. The salary schedule for 2019-20 will be contingent on the licensed cost of living adjustment (COLA).

Compensation schedules which apply to specific groups within the bargaining unit are available on the District website and by this reference are incorporated in this Agreement.
