Eligibility INFORMATION

1. **Applicant must be a child or grandchild of an OSEA Chapter 48 signed member in good standing (dues paying member) as of December 31, 2019.**
2. Current high school seniors and graduates may apply.
3. Applicants must plan to attend an accredited college or vocational school to pursue one of the following:
 - a. A specialized training program certificate or degree
 - b. A Bachelor or Associate Degree
4. Application **must** include a high school transcript if in high school currently.
If the applicant is in college or attended college at any point, you must include **both** a high school and a most current college transcript with the application.
5. Include your own typed essay of at least 500 words. As this award is coming from OSEA members' dues dollars; your essay must include **"What being part of a Union means"** along with describing your educational interests, plans, and activities (inside and outside of school/work).

This application, including the above information **must be received by Thursday April 2, 2020 by 4:00pm.**
